Mercer Last Time Out

The Mercer baseball team used a five-run seventh inning to erase a four-run deficit and then held on for an 8-6 victory at Kennesaw State. Although being out-hit 10-9, the Bears posted five extra base hits to grab the win. Justin Boyette threw the first five to grab the victory and Josh Lowey hurled the final out to pick up his second save of the season. Joe Winker and John Dortch each tallied two hits and a home run. Dan April allowed just two runs, fanned six and scattered seven hits en route to the Bears 5-2 victory in game one of the doubleheader. John Hoelzer threw the last 1.2 to grab the save from the mound. A solo shot in the fourth by Mike Armstrong and a three-RBI jack by John Moreland was enough for the Bears to take the win. Mercer gave up five hits and three runs in the final two innings, allowing the Owls to escape with the 5-4 victory in game three. Tyler McCarty and Tyler Brown each tallied three hits. Reliever John Hoelzer was tagged with the loss.

A Look at the Yellow Jackets

Last Time Out: Georgia Tech (28-12) enters the game having lost five of its last seven games. The Yellow Jackets avoided a series sweep by taking game three, 9-6, at ACC foe Maryland over the weekend. The Ramblinwreck dropped the first two games, 7-5 and 14-13.

Key Players: Luke Murton and Charlie Blackmon power GT's offense, batting .378 and .366 respectively. Murton adds a team-best .697 slugging percent while Blackmon leads the squad with 56 hits and 16 stolen bases. Deck McGuire anchors the Yellow Jacket pitching staff with a perfect 6-0 record and 3.28 ERA.

Last Meeting: Mercer nearly pulled off the upset of then No. 17 Georgia Tech back on March 19 at Russ Chandler Stadium. The Bears out-hit the Yellow Jackets 15 to 9, but fell 7-6 as Blackmon sent a two-out, two-RBI single to right field in the bottom of the eighth to lead the Ramblinwreck to victory. Dortch was a double shy of the cycle, going three-for-five with three RBI. Armstrong added three hits and two RBI for the Bears.

A Look at the Catamounts

Last Time Out: Western Carolina (18-20) is set to host Clemson on Tuesday before heading down to Macon on Wednesday. A suicide squeeze by Jason Haynes in the top of the tenth inning gave the Catamounts a 5-4 win over Appalachian State in the final game of a Sunday doubleheader, allowing a split for the day as Western Carolina fell in the opening game, 12-8.

Key Players: Offensive powerhouse Blake Murphy is batting .325 with 12 doubles and 13 homers to tally a team-best .738 slugging percent along with 17 stolen bases and a .517 on-base-percentage. Nick Liles leads the Catamounts from the box with a .369 average and 65 hits.

Last Meeting: Mercer slugged out a 13-10 win over Western Carolina on March 7 last season. The Bears were out-hit 20-15, but the Catamounts stranded 15 runners on base while Mercer notched four home runs. Steve Karwatt led the attack going three-for-five and registering career-highs in RBI (5), runs scored (3) and home runs (2). Tyler Brown also went three-for-five and Matt Crawford registered a pair of hits in the victory.

A Look at the Bears

The .300 Club: As a team, the Bears are hitting an impressive .313, with seven starters above the mark. The list includes *Mike Armstrong* (.348), *Billy Shaughnessy* (.342), *John Dortch* (.342), *Matt Crawford* (.342), *Joe Winker* (.342), *Tyler Brown* (.307) and *Tyler McCarty* (.303).

Career Game: Sophomore *Nick DiMauro* had a career day at the plate in the Bears 27-1 victory over Savannah State on April 16. DiMauro set new career bests in hits (4), at-bats (7), RBI (7) and notched his first career home run with a bases loaded grand slam in the third inning.

Southpaw Sling: After appearing in 15 games as the Bears' primary reliever, *Dan April* has moved into the starting rotation and is leading the staff with a 2.47 earned run average and holding opponents to a mere .225 batting average. April ranks first in the league, allowing just 12 earned runs and 34 hits.

Slugging Power: Senior *John Dortch* leads the squad with 43 RBI and is tied for first with 16 extra base hits and a .535 slugging percentage.

Top of the Class: Senior *Mike Armstrong* ranks first on the team with a .348 batting average, 57 hits and a .446 on-base-percentage.

Gold Glove: The Mercer baseball squad currently ranks second in the Atlantic Sun with a .967 fielding percentage.

Hitting Showcase: The Bears lead the league with 489 hits, averaging 11.6 hits per game. Mercer has out-hit its opponets in 24 games this season.

Start it Off Right: Leadoff hitter *Matt Crawford* has tallied a .418 on-base-percentage when leading off an inning. Crawford adds a team-high 19 multiple hit games and notched the squad's longest hitting streak of the season, 12 games.

It Takes Two: First baseman *Mike Armstrong* and shortstop *Billy Shaughnessy* have combined to turn 28 double plays this season.

Take an Extra Base: Redshirt freshman *Joe Winker* has tallied 12 doubles to lead the team and is tied on the squad with a .535 slugging percentage.

Two Outs, No Problem: As a team, the Bears are hitting .315 when stepping to the plate with two outs. Freshman *John Moreland* and *Thomas Carroll* lead the way, each batting .500. Senior *John Dortch* adds a team-best 15 RBI while Moreland adds 15 RBI when at the plate with two outs.

Caught Fire: Senior *Tyler Brown* is currently riding a seven game hitting streak and has safely hit in 14 of his last 15 games, mounting a .307 batting average and .509 slugging percent.

Home Sweet Home: Senior *Billy Shaughnessy* leads the Bears at Claude Smith Field with a .400 batting average and .479 on-base-percentage.

One Run Blunders: The Bears have played in 17 games that have been decided by one run. Of these 17 games, the Mercer baseball squad has been successful in just four of the games.

Runaround: The Bears are 9-1 in games in which they have scored 10 or more runs. Their only blemish came in an 11-10 loss to Jacksonville.

Late Inning Confidence: The Mercer baseball squad is 15-1 in games in which it was leading at the end of the seventh inning.

Up Next: The Bears conclude their five-game home stand with a three-game conference series against Gardner-Webb. Game one is set for Friday, April 25 at 6 p.m. with a doubleheader to follow at noon on Saturday, April 26.

Head Coach Craig Gibson - Fifth Season



Mercer head coach Craig Gibson has helped put the Bears among the elite squads in the Atlantic Sun Conference heading into 2008. Last season, the Bears posted a 33-25 record and a second-place finish in the Atlantic Sun. Mercer started the year with a two game sweep of Miami, Fla., won 13-of-14 games midway through the season and lost a heartbreaker to Stetson in the conference tournament. Pitcher Cory Gearrin was drafted by the Atlanta Braves and catcher Josh Thompson was chosen by the Florida Marlins in the 2007 draft. The Bears mounted their third consecutive season over .500.

The 2006 season was highlighted by victories over No. 1 Florida and No. 1 Clemson. Closer Andrew Urena finished second in the nation in saves with 15, and earned All-America honors from several publications. Urena was chosen by the Chicago White Sox in the June major league draft. Mercer's 2007 recruiting class was tabbed as one of the nation's best according to *Collegiate Baseball*.

In 2005, Gibson guided the Bears back above .500, marking the first time Mercer had finished the season with a winning record since 1999. In the process, the Bears set a new school record with eight shutouts and defeated Southwest Missouri State, who finished the season ranked in the Top 25.

Gibson became the third head coach at Mercer University since 1948 at the start of the 2004 season. Barry Myers hung up his spikes after 26 years at Mercer and the Bears did not have to go far to find their new leader.

In his first campaign as head coach, Gibson led his young squad to a 20-35 record, a nine-win improvement from the previous season. The 2004 Bears had just three seniors on the roster, and of the eight juniors on the squad, only one had played for Mercer in 2003. The rest of the junior class had transferred to Mercer looking for a chance to win.

Mercer opened the 2004 season with a victory over Florida A&M for Gibson's first career win on January 24, 2004. On March 20, 2004, the Bears defeated Jacksonville 2-0, for Gibson's first Atlantic Sun Conference victory. The Bears won two-of-three games against Troy on April 23-24, 2004 for the first conference series win during the Craig Gibson Era.

Gibson started his career at Mercer as a player. His junior year, the hard-hitting first baseman earned Atlantic Sun Conference Player of the Year honors, while leading the Bears to the Atlantic Sun Tournament and a second-place finish in the regular season.

Following his playing career, Gibson served as a

graduate assistant coach on Myers' staff. He then took over as the head baseball coach at Jupiter Community High School in Jupiter, Fla., for two years before moving over to Suncoast Community High School in Riviera Beach, Fla., for one season. Gibson wrapped up his high school coaching career in 1993 as the head coach at Palm Beach Gardens High School in Palm Beach, Fla.

In August 1993, Gibson got the call to come home and serve as an assistant under Myers. With his strong ties to Mercer and a wealth of coaching experience, it made Athletics Director Bobby Pope's choice an easy one when he elevated Gibson to the head job following Myers resignation.

During his time as an assistant, Gibson coached four players who were drafted by the Major Leagues and helped lead Mercer to two A-Sun divisional titles. The Bears also advanced to the A-Sun Tournament three times, finishing as high as third in 1999. The 1999 team was one of the best Gibson worked with, finishing in a tie for third place in the A-Sun at 19-11 and going 36-24 overall.

On top of his victories on the field, Gibson was a winner in the classroom, earning a bachelor's degree in history and health, physical education and recreation, and a master's of education in social science from Mercer.

A native of Macon, Ga., Gibson and his wife Diane have two children, Tyler and Lindsey.
